Panel members cannot be employees of the Trust, however as a panel member you would be joining a team that is dedicated, committed, confident and fully patient focused.

If you are looking for self-employed sessional work, are confident, able to interpret complex guidance, have an empathy to the needs of patients, who may have challenging and enduring mental health needs, and have an understanding of the work of the Trust and its values, then this may be a role for you. Full training and shadowing experience will be provided as part of your induction period. There is a sessional fee and mileage payable.
