3. What was the date of your most recent update of the adult learning disability register?
4. Is the data from your register still available?
5. If so, is this data publicly available? Please note if data is available we will seek to collect this at a later date. Who is the best person to contact for this information?
6. If you do have an adult learning disability register, do you plan to continue collecting information beyond April 2011? Please note we recognise that this is a future projection and that you may not have exact information. However, an idea of the current intention (e.g. yes/no) would be useful.
7. How many adults with a learning disability are known to social services in your local authority area?

Our Response

OUR RESPONSE: The Leicestershire Learning Disability Register was established in 1987 and helps to provide and monitor services for people with learning disabilities and their carers living anywhere in Leicestershire, Leicester City and Rutland. It is a Register for adults aged 19 and over.

2. What was the date of your most recent update of the adult learning disability register?

OUR RESPONSE: The data is generally updated on a daily basis.

7. How many adults with a learning disability are known to social services in your local authority area?

OUR RESPONSE: There are 3794 people (alive and eligible) on the Register as at 11 May 2011. Of these 2660 are or have been known to a Social worker at some point.
