- * The total spend by the Council on the provision of speech and language therapy in the 2009/10 and 2010/11 financial year.
- * The number of speech and language therapists employed by the Council as at 5 April 2010 and 4 April 2011 (full time equivalent).
- * The number of 0-25 year olds registered as receiving speech and language therapy as at 4 April 2011.
- * The budget allocated for the provision of speech and language therapy services in the 2011/12 financial year.
- * The projected number of speech and language therapists employed by the Council as at 2 April 2012 (full time equivalent).
- * The projected number of 0-25 year olds registered as receiving speech and language therapy as at 4 April 2011.

Our Response

Further to your request below, which was forwarded to me as the FOI manager for Leicestershire Partnership Trust. As you may know Leicestershire County and Rutland Community Health Services (LCRCHS) and Leicester City Community Health Services (LCCHS) became part of Leicestershire Partnership Trust on 1st April 2011 and Leicester City Children's Services have been able to provide the following information in response to Questions 3 and 6 of the FOI request:

- * *The number of 0-25 year olds registered as receiving speech and language therapy as at 4 April 2011 = 3,043*
- * *The projected number of 0-25 year olds registered as receiving speech and language therapy as at 4 April 2011 = 2,894 (we think he means 4 April 2012 - this figure is based on the assumption that year on year trends of referrals and discharges between 09/10 – 10/11 are maintained)*
